The Analysis Centre supports German physicists working on analysis at ATLAS, CMS and the ILC in areas like Monte Carlo generators, parton distribution functions and statistics tools. It also holds workshops on these subjects ranging from beginners tutorials to expert workshops. The Analysis Centre will consist of approximately 10-15 people. The leader is supposed to coordinate the work of the Analysis Centre and to keep the contact with the management of the alliance and with the physics community. It is also expected that he or she will work on research within one of the alliance projects for about 50% of his or her time.

The position will be for an initial duration of five years and can become permanent in case of positive evaluation. If the successful candidate already holds a permanent position it can be made permanent from the beginning.
